FAQ FOR CAREER CLINIC CANDIDATES



1. What kind of counselling is provided in career clinic services?

Our experts will help you develop your potential to grow in different areas where you need support which will help increase your chances to have a successful career.

Our sessions are based on generic development in candidate, and it is more focused on General Career Counselling, but our experts may help you with specific questions relating to your field

2. What is the time limit of one session?

One session with our expert is maximum of 1 hour.

3. How many sessions I can get with an expert?

One person can have maximum 3 different sessions of 1 hour each with our expert. The sessions have to be completed within 2 months.

4. What are the fees for the counselling?

Career Clinic has been started to help migrants grow their career journey and Migrant Career Support Trust is proudly providing this service for FREE of charge for all migrants. No fees will be charged to the candidates.

This service has been funded via various government and charitable funds.

In case the candidates take any extra services from the experts, that needs to be paid for and decided between them individually. MCST does not take any role in deciding that.

5. Who are the selected Individuals to get this service?

Anyone can put the request to get access to this service and Migrant Career Support Trust will be helping candidates to match them with a best

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expert according to their requirements. There is no entry criteria, except that they should not be holding a visitor visa or based overseas.

6. Can I get counselling if I am on Visitor Visa?

This service is available to all visa holders EXCEPT VISITOR VISA holders. You can still register your interest with Migrant Career Trust.

7. Who are the experts providing the service?

Our experts come from wide range of areas with proven successful backgrounds in different industries. The experts are all qualified and registered career practitioners. List of profiles may be provided on request subject to approval by the authorised person of Migrant Career Support Trust.

8. Where will the Career Clinic services be provided?

These services sessions will be provided in two different forms of meeting

- Physical Meetings: First and third meeting
- Zoom Meeting: second meeting

Physical meeting will be held at Migrant Career Support Trust office situated at: Palm Space Offices, 4343 Great North Road, Glendene, Auckland, New Zealand.

9. Can this service be provided in any other language than English?

A request can be made at the time of registration to have sessions in a specific language which will be subject to approval and availability of our experts. We will try our best to provide an expert familiar with your language or culture.

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10. Will this service help me get a Job?

Career Clinic is a service which is being provided to maximise your chances to get a job. Our experts will identify areas where you are lacking and will help you improve upon those. However, we do not guarantee to get a job for you.

11. Can this process help me in extending my visa?

Our services don't help you in any way to extend your visas. It only provides you with the support you need in advancing your career.

12. What other help can career clinic provide me with?
