### Job Seeker Boot Camps & Webinars

Physical workshops, focused on hard and soft skills relevant to the New Zealand job market, targeting specific ethnic groups.

Conducted 20 physical workshops and 25 online events, reaching over 2000 migrants.

### Career Clinic

Clients get access to 3, one-hour personalised counselling sessions from registered career counsellors.

Offered more than 120 hours of career consultations, benefiting migrants from diverse ethnic backgrounds.

### Stepping into Governance

We we inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Governance New Zealand Inc. for delivering governance training to ethnic communities.

We started workshops on Governance Training Workshop for Ethnic Communities, with the inaugural being held on 28 October 2023.
